About the Marian Shrine of the Unborn (Burial Site of 157 Aborted Babies) in Newton Grove, North Carolina

In 1988, Day of Remembrance sponsor organizations Citizens for a Pro-Life Society (CPLS) and the Pro-Life Action League (PLAL) discovered that a pathology lab in Northbrook, Illinois was dumping aborted babies on a loading dock connected to the pathology lab.

The babies were left out in boxes to be picked up by a waste incinerator company and burnt with trash. These aborted babies were being shipped to Vital Med from abortion clinics all over the country.

One of the clinics was the Raleigh Women's Health Organization. Members of the two groups knew exactly where the babies came from because they were on the loading dock in the boxes shipped to the lab by parcel post and the return labels of the clinics were on all of the boxes.

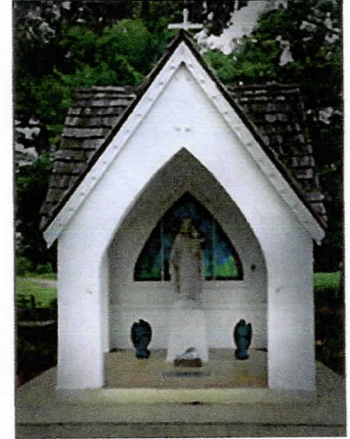
Babies Given Burial in their Home State

A funeral service was held for these 157 babies at Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Raleigh, North Carolina, and they were taken to Our Lady of Guadalupe Cemetery in Newton Grove, North Carolina for burial.

CPLS and the PLAL began this retrieval of the aborted babies in February of 1988 and this lasted until October of that year.

Over 5000 bodies were retrieved and needed to be buried. Monica Migliorino Miller, the director of CPLS arranged for most of the burials and made a decision that, whenever possible, the aborted babies would be returned to the cities where they had been killed and given to pro-lifers in those cities to bury.
