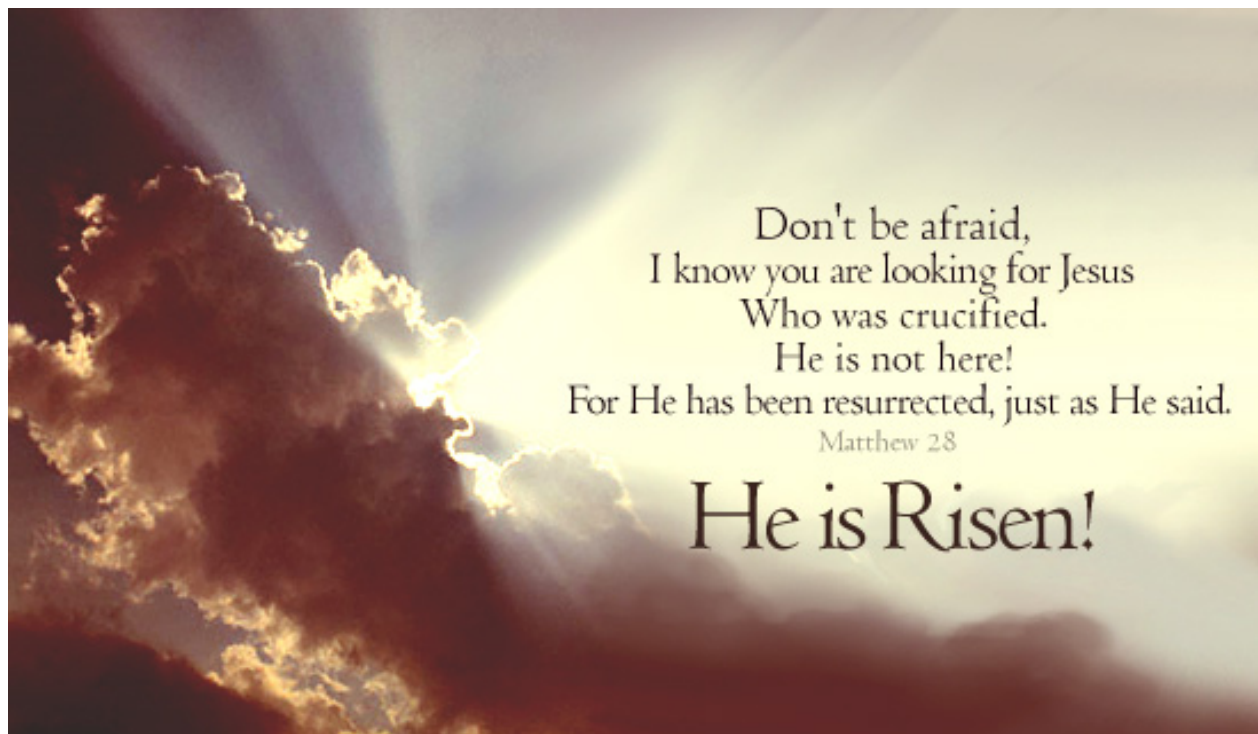

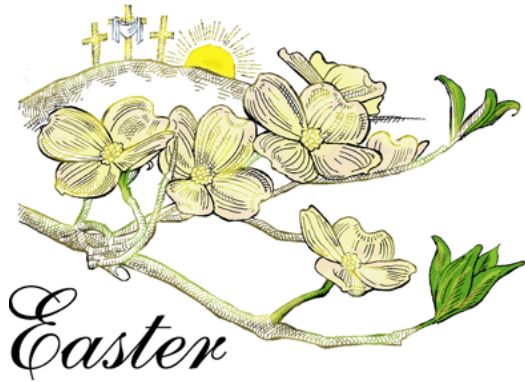

### Be an Easter people!

*“Alleluia! Alleluia! Christ is Risen, He is Risen indeed, Alleluia!”* I want to extend wishes for a beautiful, joyful and blessed Easter to all parishioners, staff, school teachers, students and visitors who have gathered here at St. Mary’s to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I greatly appreciate the extra time and dedication given by our school teachers and staff. In a special way, I would like to thank the choirs and Mrs. Sears and the liturgical committee for all the extra hours of work that were involved in making our church so beautiful and liturgically appropriate for the celebrations of Holy Week and Easter. Thanks also to those who helped in any way to set-up and/or decorate. I also thank Deacon Webster, our altar servers, lectors, EMEs, ushers, volunteers. Together we have been blessed to use our time and talents to praise and adore our Risen Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Easter is the principal feast of the ecclesiastical year. Leo I (Sermo xlvii in Exodum) calls it the greatest feast ( *festum festorum* ),...” It is also the oldest feast of the Christian Church, as old as Christianity. A feast that serves a link between the Old and New Testaments; the Jewish Passover and the Christian feast of Easter.

Easter reminds us that Jesus has destroyed the power of sin and death and brought us into His life. Christ has won for us victory over the grave. The church in her wisdom asks us to keep this feast alive for fifty days. And not only that, but Easter is also celebrated every Sunday when we all gather together to praise our Lord. I extend to you the love and mercy of our Risen Lord and sincerely invite you back into the fold of Holy Mother Church.

This year of Mercy has been a true blessing for me. It has reminded me about true Christianity, not a religion that is apathetic of the reality of the world but that exactly exists to enlighten the world with her message and example.

In his last year’s Easter Message, Pope Francis invited all of us to “become agents of this mercy, channels through which God can water the earth, protect all creation and make justice and peace flourish,” (*Pope Francis Easter morning Mass March 31, 2015*)

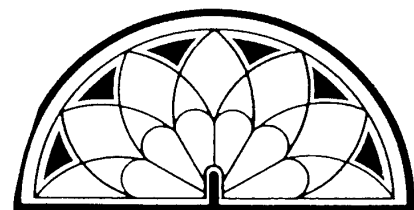
